# Frequently asked questions

**When is prom?** – May 4, 2024, from 7 – 11 pm

**Where is prom?** - The Foundry at Puritan Mill 916 Joseph E Lowery Blvd NW Atlanta, GA 30318

### How much are the tickets?

Senior Early Bird Special - \$100 from 11/15/23 - 1/30/24 Starting 2/1/2023, All payments must be made in person via cash, money order, or check. Tickets can be purchased from Mrs. Williams in the counseling office and from Ms. Hutchinson before 7:30am and after school.

Seniors - \$110 Juniors - \$120

Non RCHS students - \$130 \*\*\*\*

Freshmen and Sophomores - \$130

\*\*\*\*NON-RCHS students must be at least 16 and no older than 20. You must have an approved permission form signed by an administrator at the time of purchase (you can download the form from the school website).

**All** tickets purchased 4/21 - 4/26 will be <u>\$150</u> Senior Early Bird tickets can be purchased via OSP (Online School Payment system). The link is on the RCHS website.

### Tickets are non-refundable.

**Where can I purchase a ticket?** Seniors can purchase a ticket starting November 15<sup>th</sup> online via the OSP system. Information is available on the RCHS webpage.

After January 30, 2024, tickets can be purchased in person at the following locations:

- Mrs. Williams in the counseling office throughout the day
- Mrs. Hutchinson (room 204) before and after school.

What is the theme? The official theme is:

Glamorous Nights Under the Garden Lights

**What is the last day to purchase a ticket?** - Last day to buy a ticket will be April 26, 2024. *No tickets will be sold at the door.* 

**Can I bring a date that doesn't go to Rockdale County High School?** – Yes. However, you must download a permission form. It is available on the school website on February 1st. The form must be returned when the ticket is purchased for the guest. The deadline to turn in this form is April 26, 2024 at 3 pm.

**Can I bring my middle school friend/sister/cousin?** No. All guests must be in high school, at least16 years of age but not more than 20 years old the day of prom.

**Can I bring more than one guest?** – No. RCHS students are only allowed <u>one</u> guest.

**Can I transfer my ticket to somebody else?** - No. Please see Mrs. Williams if you have additional questions on this.

**Can parents take pictures inside?** – No. Parents will not be able to enter the venue. Only ticket holders will be allowed to enter the venue. Additionally, non-ticket holders will not be allowed to remain onsite after drop off.

**Is there a dress code for prom?** Yes. Please remember that Prom is a FORMAL and CLASSY event. To ensure you are appropriately dressed for the occasion, please follow these guidelines:

- Formal dresses or cocktail dresses are great! Dresses/skirts should be an appropriate length. Formal dresses cannot be shorter than fingertip length with arms fully extended. Dress slits may not be higher than thumb length with arms fully extended.
- Dresses with the back out are allowed but cannot open all the way to the top of the buttocks. The back of the dress may not be lower than the natural waistline (belly button).
- Chest should be fully covered, not cut too low.
- Midriff should not be showing.
- Pants suits are permissible.
- Tuxedo, dress pants & shirt or suit and tie are permissible. Collared dress shirt with long sleeves with a jacket or blazer are great. Shirts must remain on for the entire dance.
- No bandanas.
- No baseball caps.
- No Jeans
- No Shorts

If you have a question about your attire, please see an administrator or Mrs. Myra Williams.

**Do I have to wear a mask?** – We will follow the current CDC guidelines applicable at the time of the event.

**Can I leave the venue and then come back inside?** - There is <u>*no reentry*</u>. Once you have left the venue, you are not allowed to reenter.

**Do I need to pay for parking?** – No. Parking is free.

**Can I show up at any time to Prom?** – Doors will open at 7 pm. No one be admitted after <u>10:30 pm</u>.

What do I need to bring with me the night of prom? Picture ID (required for admission), and your dancing shoes.

**Am I allowed to bring a bag?** – Students are allowed to bring a small handbag. Bookbags are not allowed.

**Will there be a photographer?** – There will be a photo booth at the event as well as a photographer providing candid pictures.

**Will there be food?** – YES! Affairs to Remember is our official caterer. There will be a variety of foods served.
